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## Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to all parents who have returned the parent questionnaire so far. We highly value your opinion on all aspects of school life and we would be very grateful to those who have not yet done so if you could spare 10 minutes completing the questionnaire. All questionnaires are anonymous and cannot be traced back to you or your child. On return, you will be issued a raffle ticket and entered into the prize draw to win one of three holiday hampers for you and your family. The deadline for return is the 14th December 2020.

Despite the many sweet treats around at this time of year, we continue to ask that if children bring a packed lunch to school their lunch boxes contain a healthy and nutritious meal that will help them retain concentration in the afternoon. We do not allow children to have fizzy drinks, chocolate bars or crisps in our dinner hall and ask that you provide healthy alternatives such as low sugar juice, chopped vegetables and dried fruit. Over the upcoming holiday period, the Government have allocated funding to support families entitled to free school meals in recognition of the continued challenges faced as a result of COVID 19. All qualifying families will be contacted with instructions of how to access vouchers with a value of £15 per week per child the week beginning the 14th December 2020. If you think you may be eligible for free school meals, please call our school office and the admin team will support you in checking.

School will finish for children on the 18th December 2020 and we will welcome everyone back on the 5th January 2021. Holiday homework will be set to support children in continuing to read and practise key maths and writing skills over the holidays. Examples of the creative project outcomes to undertake will also be in the holiday homework pack. Working on these together supports children in developing an understanding of their upcoming half termly topic learning and will support lots of opportunities for parents, grandparents and the wider family to talk about school learning over the upcoming half term. Don't forget, there are many 'fun' ways to incorporate reading, writing and maths into the holiday period too from calculating scores in games to following instructions in recipes!

## YEAR 6 MATHS BOOSTER

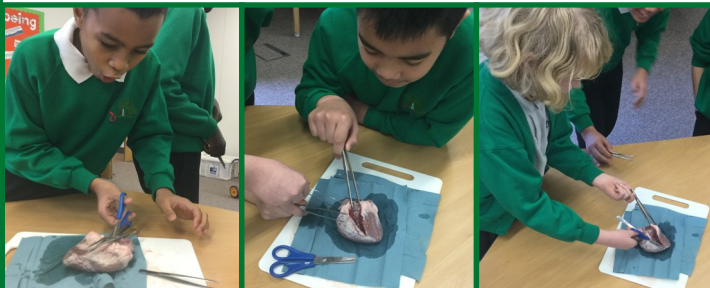

## YEAR 6 HEART WORKSHOP

Year 6 participated in a heart workshop linking to their Science unit. They had the opportunity to dissect a heart, and identify various parts of it, including the different ventricles and chambers. They also learned a bit more about how to keep a healthy heart and what the consequences are of not keeping a healthy lifestyle.



## MATHS IN YEAR 1

During maths this week, Year 1 have been exploring the concept of division. They started by using cubes to share a number equally between different groups. The children then used this strategy to explore a range of different amounts, making connections to multiplication and addition by writing number sentences.



## COFFEE MORNINGS AND DROP INS

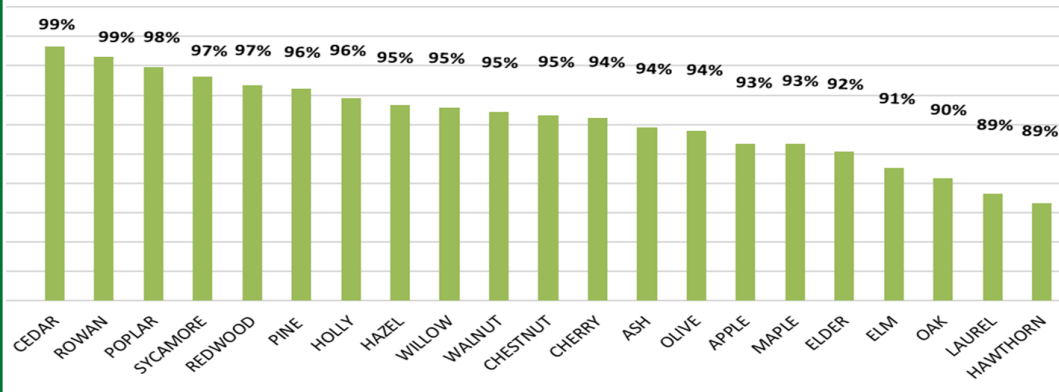
