#### Dear Parents and Carers.

Our recent parent survey analysis has now been completed and we received 346 responses in total. The outcomes have shown the community thoughts and feelings about our school provision. Some of the highlights from the survey include:

- 96% said the school provides a good education for their child.
- 93% said their child likes school.
- 92% said their child feels their teachers work hard and teach well.
- 91% said the termly reports are useful.

Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete this. We take all feedback very seriously and the leadership team will be reviewing all contributions to the survey across this half term for things we can do even better.

At the very beginning of each school day children set straight to task whilst the teacher calls the register. This often involves rehearsing key skills such as spellings, handwriting or times tables. This is also the time that many children read one to one with an adult or receive additional help. When children arrive to the classroom late, they do not only miss out on their own learning time, but it disrupts this time for other children in the class. Please help us by making sure that children are on time and in the playground ready to line up at 8:55am to come into school with their class.

Despite the changeable weather, we are keen that children get fresh air and play outside each day so please make sure that they bring a warm coat, hat and gloves to school and that these are clearly marked with their name in case they get lost. Remember, we expect children to wear black school shoes whilst at school and not boots for safety reasons, as well as to make sure children are comfortable when in class. PE at this time of the year mostly takes place indoors but we still expect all children to have a white t-shirt, plain green shorts or black jogging bottoms as their PE kit.

### **EYFS SIX DINNER SID**

Children in Reception have been reading *Six Dinner Sid*. They have used their phonic knowledge to describe Sid and developed their fine motor skills by drawing and designing a cat collage. Outside they have explored the movement of a cat!



### **GARAGEBAND YEAR 6**

In Music sessions, Year 6 have been exploring the app Garageband to compose their own songs. First pupils selected a drum loop and then recorded a chord sequence. Next week, children will complete their songs then share these with each other to identify improvements to make.

In Poplar Class, pupils have applied their ICT skills in their PSHE lesson by using Google slides to create a presentation about what they aspire to be when they grow up. As a class, children then listened and asked questions as each other presented their slides.

Debate Mate for Year 5 and 6 pupils has resumed this term, with both groups preparing for the upcoming tournament. Our debaters are learning how to confidently express their ideas clearly and in response to the opposing view.

In Ash Class, the children used images to sequence the story of Rama and Sita in RE. The children worked with a partner to use key vocabulary to retell the key events to others.


